Living Bread Food Pantry

The Plainville United Methodist Church has a food assistance program that is available to all Plainville residents who find themselves in need due to low income, disabilities, etc. The Living Bread Food Pantry was established in 1985 to address hunger and provide emergency food assistance. The Pantry is open every Wednesday from 6:30 – 7:00 p.m.

On your first visit you will need to fill out a form with name, address, number in family, income, etc. You will be asked to show proof of residency with a license and bill with your current address. Every time you come into the Pantry, you will be signed in. Only one person per address may pick up one bag of non-perishable foods weekly. Unfortunately, supplies do run low at times and this helps us to serve everyone better.

Your bag will include a vegetable, fruit, soup, meat, boxed meals, pasta & sauce. We also try to include rice, condiment, and baking item if available. We have a weekly special posted on the bulletin board. Out of these specials we always have peanut butter on the first Wednesday of the month and coffee on the second Wednesday. Every week you can choose from cereal, breads, and desserts. During the summer we may have fresh vegetables donated. Sometimes we need to limit your choices but you can come back at 7:00 p.m. to see if there are extra foods left.

The Food Pantry cannot be responsible for outdated foods. Please check dates, smell, color, and sharp dents before using.
